In 2025 our total expenditure came to £93k. Our budgeted expenditure for 2026 is £95k which includes our £21k contribution towards the Diocesan Common Fund. It excludes any one off significant expenditure on, for example, the church's roof or heating system. This means that, before our contribution to the Common Fund, it costs just over £200 a day to keep our church open. At our recent Annual Meeting it was suggested that, in addition to the flyers on giving at the back of church, the church's bank details should be printed on our bulletin in the event that someone would like to set up regular giving via standing order.
